





be a true witness in the world to you.*






My Confirmation Name








The Parables of Jesus




The Stations of the Cross

Here are my drawn images and titles for the 14 stations.





It is essentially a compilation of each child's own musings, writings, drawings, illustrations and photographs.


It is a repository of their reflections and memories as they journey towards receiving confirmation.
